- ✓ Have you specified your short-term goals?
- ✓ Have you specified your long-term goals?
- ✓ Have you given presentations at seminars / departmental seminars / journal clubs?
- ✓ Have you presented data at external conferences or meetings?
- ✓ Have you collected your credit points?
- ✓ Was your project already running when you started your work? Are other colleagues of your research group working on the same topic? If so, do you think this is problematic?
- ✓ Do you have sufficient resources?
- ✓ Do you have the feeling that your work progressed adequately? If not, what are the reasons?
- ✓ Are publications in sight? Have publication merits been arranged?
- ✓ You have been working for 2.5 years now. Is the end in sight?
  - $\circ$   $\;$  If yes, prepare a time schedule for writing and handing in the thesis.
  - o If no, you have to arrange a fourth meeting next year.
- ✓ Do you have a strategy for your transition period between PhD and Postdoc (or else)?

- ✓ Be aware that you can always contact your co-supervisors without your supervisor if you have questions or are facing problems.
